MARINE SHUT-OFF DAMPERS



Shut-off dampers are used to stop the air flow within ductworks or behind air intake grilles for ships and offshore installations.

They can be required for safety reasons as a fire protection component as they isolate sections of air conditioning or ventilation systems in case of fire on board.

They are designed for open or close postion, with manual or automatic operation.

Shut-off dampers are available with remote electrical (standard or ATEX), pneumatic (linear or rotating) or manual actuators.

If fitted with an automatic control device, they are operated by means of a remote electric or pneumatic signal (usually from a fire damper installed on the same duct).

With electrical or pneumatic actuated dampers, the closing/opening blades tests can be made at any moment by remote control.



CONSTRUCTION

- · Damper housing is made out of strong bath-galvanized steel sheet, with thickness of 3 mm.
- · Double sheet blades are made of electrolytic galvanized steel, with 1 + 1 mm thickness.
- · Housing and blades are available on request in varnished steel, AISI 304 or AISI 316 stainless steel.
- · Shafts, mounted into bronze self lubricating bearings, are made of AISI 316 stainless steel.
- · Connections to circular ducts are available on request.



OPERATION

- ·Shut-off dampers are designed for open or close normal working condition.
- · When they are open, the blade aerodynamic profile allows air flow into the duct without any significant noise or pressure drop. When they are closed, special gaskets guarantee a perfect seal with very low gas leakage.

INSTALLATION

- · Shut-off dampers are suitable for horizontal or vertical applications, with airflow in any direction.
- ·The blade aerodynamic profile allows to obtain very low pressure drop and noise levels with the damper in the open position.
- · Is available for high levels of sealing (gas tight) with leakage value of only 0.04 m3/s for each m2 of air flow section with a negative pressure of 2000 Pa.
- \cdot Dampers are suitable both for deck and bulkhead installation.
- · All models can be fitted on rectangular or circular ducts.







gas leakage according to EN1751


Leakage test across closed blades


DAMPER CONTROLS

Type C 22 - Manual drive

This damper version is provided with a control handle (C22).

Shut-off dampers + C22 can be used also as a balancing damper; in fact the handle can be fixed in all different positions from fully open to fully closed.

A safety clamp blocks the handle in the selected position.

DAMPER CONTROLS

Type **E** - **Electrical actuator**

Type X - Electrical ATEX zone approved actuator

Marine shut-off dampers can be provided with more than 50 different electrical actuators in order to fulfill to all technical specifications or customer demands:

- deflecting torque (5,10,15,30..Nm)
- voltage input (24V...230V AC,DC)
- additional micro switches
- cable length (1, 3, 5 metres)
- spring return speed (20, 15, 10, 3 s)
- ATEX zone approved (1,2, 21, 22)
- Accessories (junction box, quick plugs connections)

While the actuator is connected to the voltage input, the damper opens and the internal spring recharges.

In case of voltage feed failure or alarm signal (from main panel) the safety internal spring return system closes blades immediately,

All actuators have two internal microswitches (signal for damper fully open or fully closed).

Additional microswitches are available.

By remote control is possible to check actuator operation and free blades movement by in/out voltage switching.

DAMPER CONTROLS

Type P - Pneumatic actuator

Shut-off dampers can be equipped with the following types of pneumatic actuators:

- Linear (1/2 bar)
- Rotating (6/8 bar)

Operation

Compressed air regulated thanks to a pressure regulator, dry and degreased, enters into the solenoid valve which is normally open thus allowing the damper actuation.

In case of air feed failure or alarm signal, the valve causes the venting of the compressed air contained in the actuator and consequently the damper closing.

Also the external operation on the solenoid valve causes the venting of the air through the valve itself. Resetting can be made from remote control.
